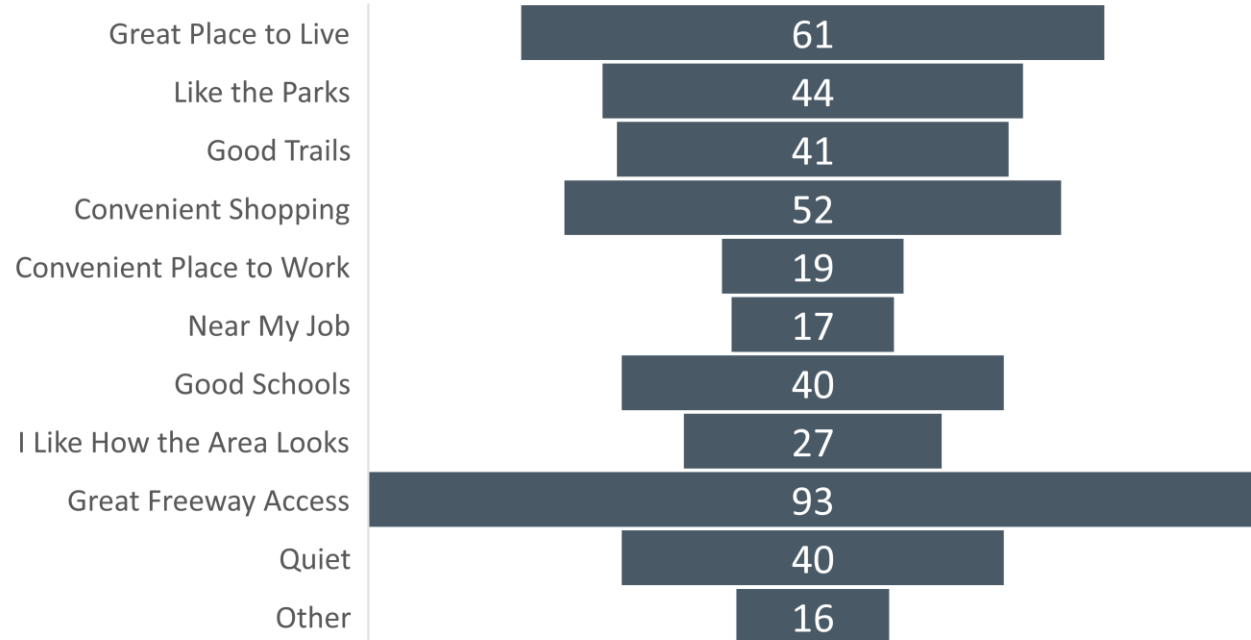

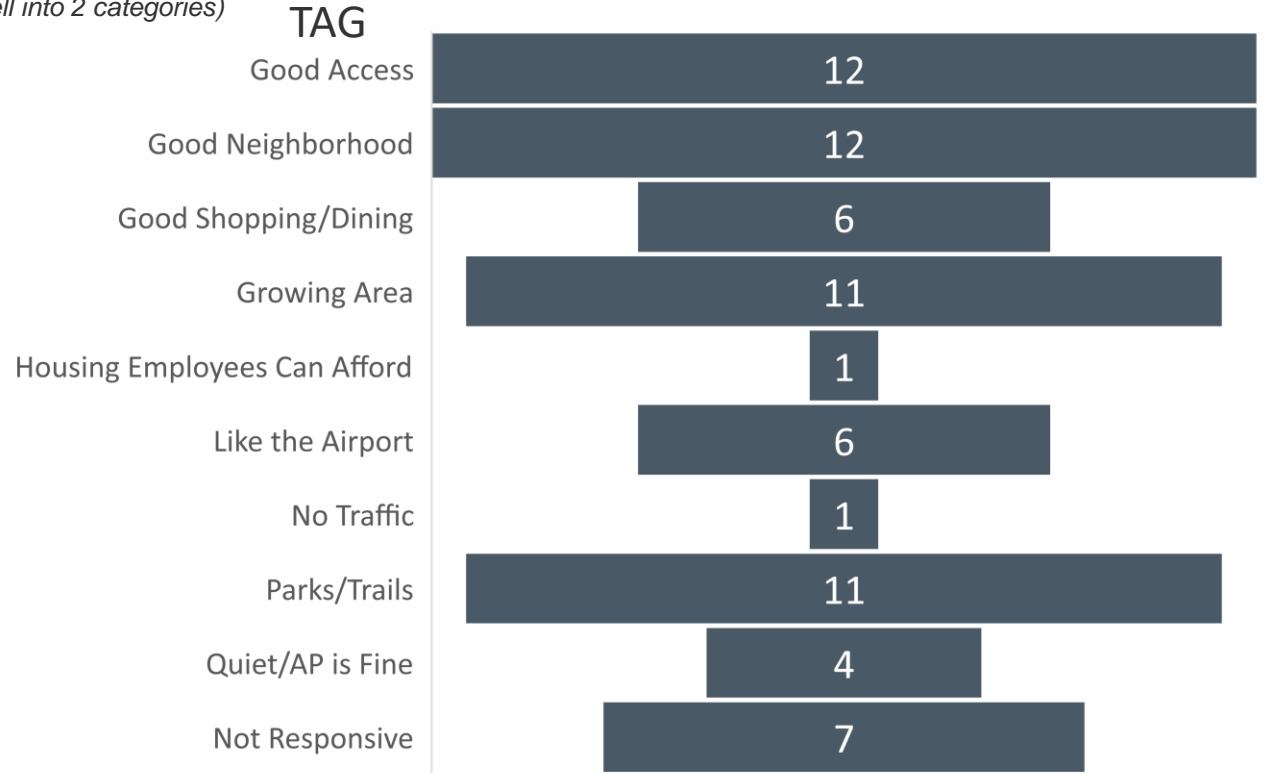
Other comments include:

People like to live or work in the Airpark Area because of its access, neighborhoods, growth, and parks and trails.

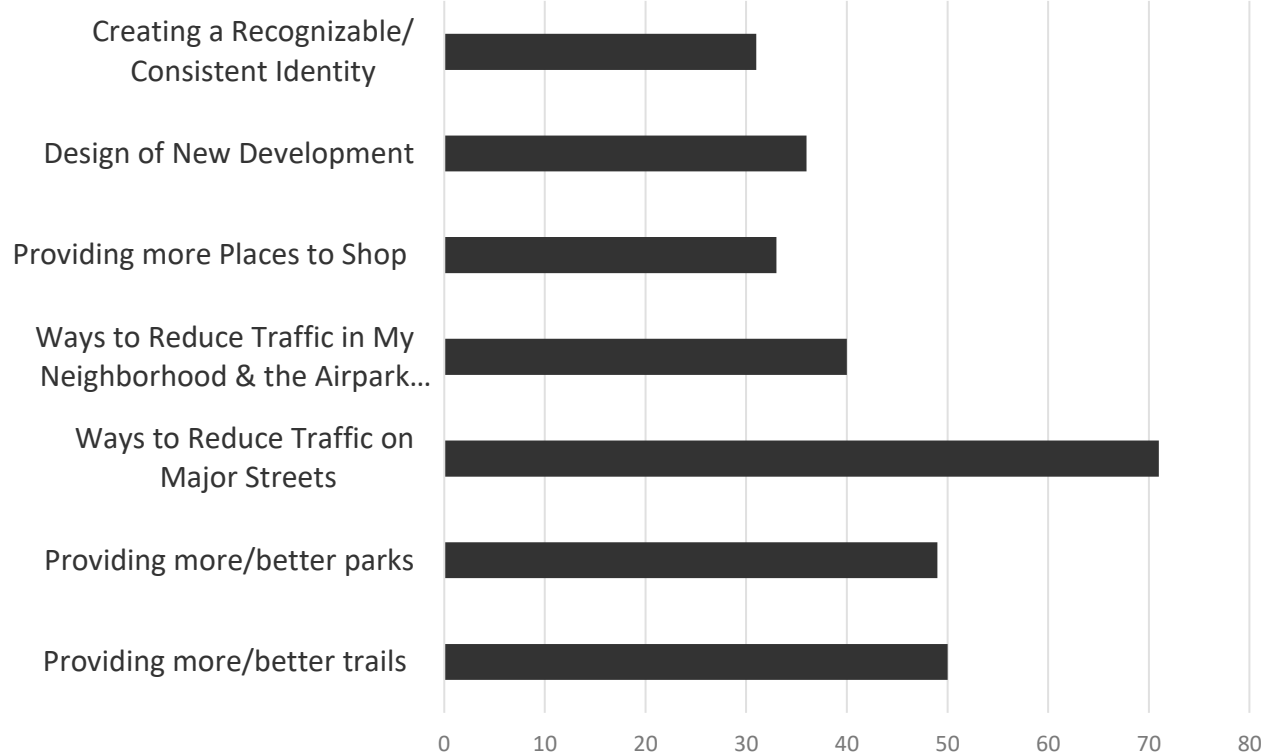


Q3: What topics do think is most important for the Airpark Area Plan to address? Choose all that apply or provide your own idea:

Answered: 124 Skipped: 14 (Total Responses = 310 as some people checked more than one item.)

Traffic throughout the Airpark Area is identified as important to address in this planning effort.

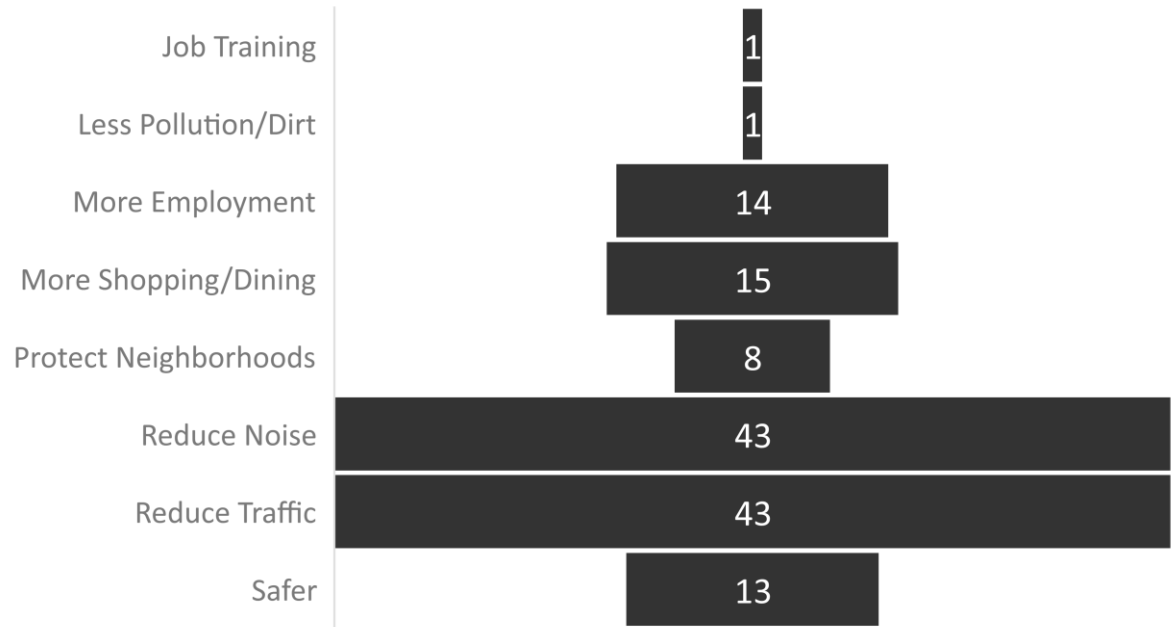
Providing parks, trails, and development design are additionally viewed as most important for the plan to address.



Q5: As new business parks and buildings continue to establish the Airpark as an employment center what are your priorities as a neighboring resident?

Answered: 118 (Total = 138 because some people identified more than one priority)

Noise & Traffic need to be considered as new development occurs. Safety & adding employment and shopping and dining is also important to residents.



Q8: Would you be opposed to moving the northern boundary of the planning area from Pecos Rd. to the Loop 202/Santan

Freeway?

Answered: 127 Skipped: 11

Generally, survey respondents are not opposed to moving the northern boundary by a 2:1 margin.
